

Please submit your safety plan to the Contract Specialist and Backup Contract Specialist listed above by email no later than Thursday, November 5, 2020 by 5:00pm in order to allow review and acceptance by WTD. You will be notified via email if your safety plan is acceptable and your staff are allowed to attend the site visit.</p> <p>Four (4) physical Site Tours will be held on <u>November 17, 2020</u>. Each site tour will last a maximum 45 minutes with a maximum of five (5) individuals (not counting King County staff) per tour. Hardhats, safety glasses, safety vests, and safety boots are required for site tour. King County will not loan out PPE.</p> <p><u>Available starting times are:</u></p> <p align="center">November 17, 2020 – 9:30am, 10:30am, 1:00pm and 2:00pm</p> <p>Bidders must make reservations to the physical Site Tour by sending emails to the Contract Specialists listed in Section 00020 Invitation To Bid, <i>including the time preferred.</i></p> <p>Reservations for a particular time will be first-come, first-served based on the email time-stamp of bidders’ requests. If no one makes a reservation, no physical Site Tour will occur.</p> <p>Meeting place of the physical Site Tour: please visit the Work Site, as identified above and remain outside of the administration building.
