Q01: We are concerned with getting the work done in the allowed 50 working days without knowing the work hour restrictions. Is there anything that can be done with the contract time?

A01: The City expects the project to be completed within the number of working days provided in the bid document. See Section 1-08.4 of the Special Provisions for additional information.

Q02: There is conflicting information regarding working hours on this project. Please confirm what is allowed.

- Specials 1-08 allows any 8 hour period between 7am - 6pm.
- The Right of Way permit (specials) allow working hours of 7am - 4pm.
- The Right of Way permit (AD1) allows working hours of 7am - 3:30pm.
- The traffic control permit (AD1) allows working hours of 8am - 3:00pm.

A02: Allowable work hours are stated in Special 1-08 within the City of Bellevue. Allowable work hours and lane closure hours within the City of Redmond are stated in the City of Redmond Right of Way permit (AD1). ~~Since the City of Redmond Right of Way permit is more restrictive than the City of Bellevue's, the allowable lane closure hours are from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm.~~ The City of Redmond approved the allowable lane closure hours to match the City of Bellevue Right of Way permit, 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.
